



## Big Piñata (Jute)



- cut 8 rectangles of jute (12x10 cm)
- blow up 1 balloon (diameter of 15 cm) & tie the end of the balloon with 1 jute fiber (length  $\approx$  8 cm)
- mix 3 tablespoons of flour (40 g) with 60 ml water
- dip the piece of jute in the flour-water-mix & glue it on the balloon (leave a hole at the top of the balloon)



- after the balloon dries, cut the fiber tying the balloon and remove the balloon (the balloon is at most reusable 2 times)
- cut 8 pieces of jute (12x10 cm) & apply a 2<sup>nd</sup> coating of jute (still leaving the balloon hole open)





- after the balloon dries, fill it with 1 teaspoon of cereal; then cut 2 pieces of jute a 12x10 cm, brush them with the flour-water-mix, and close the hole at the top
- let the piñata dry again (picture below: finished dried piñata)
